

Part of Ocean	Location	Characteristics	Information
Continental Shelf	Beside the continent (land)	-shallow -0-430 feet deep	Lots of life and recreation
Continental Slope	Past the continental shelf	-steep drop	currents brush against it
Continental Rise	Bottom of the continental slope	Gentle slope of sediments deposited by currents	sediments: clay, mud, sand from continental slope settle here
Abyssal Plain	Ocean Floor	Flat, cold, lightless, lots of pressure	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ -3 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles deep
Trench	Ocean Floor	a deep, narrow valley	Deepest Trench is Mariana Trench 6.6 miles deep
Seamount	Ocean Floor	Magma from divergent plates cools and builds high enough to create islands	Hawaiian islands were created this way

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
